



NORTH CAROLINA NATIVE AMERICAN YOUTH ORGANIZATION

The North Carolina Native American Youth Organization (NCNAYO) was established in June 1980 at the First Annual Indian Youth Unity Conference. Its primary purposes are to promote a sense of unity and cultural development for Indian youth in North Carolina, provide a forum to voice concerns and issues that affect both them and their communities, and establish a setting conducive for the development of leadership abilities and educational achievements and opportunities.

NCNAYO is a non-profit organization governed by an executive board which consists of a chairperson, vice chairperson, secretary, treasurer, parliamentarian, senior male and female representatives, and area representatives from each of the tribal and urban Indian communities in North Carolina.

The governing board of NCNAYO is comprised of 50 Indian youth from across the state that are between the ages of 13 and 18 years old. They share the responsibility of planning and directing the Annual Indian Youth Unity Conference, along with other activities that further promote Indian youth leadership development. NCNAYO has a youth representative who sits on the board of directors for the North Carolina Commission of Indian Affairs and the United Tribes of North Carolina, two statewide Indian advocacy organizations. The North Carolina Commission of Indian Affairs acts as the advisory organization for NCNAYO.


