The Waccamaw Siouan Tribal Organization was founded in 1971 and incorporated with the state of North Carolina in 1972. It serves the health, education and economic needs of the Waccamaw Siouan Indians who number around two-thousand. Tribal policy is formed by the Tribal Council which consist of seven elected members who are drawn from the communities and serve on the council for a tenure of three years. The Tribal Council hires a staff to carry out the day-to-day operations of the association and to insure compliance with the goals and objectives of the Waccamaw Siouan Tribe.
