The project consists of the elevation of four (4) residential structures to a Finished Floor Elevation (FFE) above the 100 Year Base Flood Elevation (BFE), including lifting of existing structure; foundation construction; utility relocation and retrofitting; and modifications to steps/porches/decks to comply with the 2012 NC State Residential Building Code. The structures included in this bid package have been inspected by the local building code authority and are assumed to be suitable for elevation without modifications to the existing superstructure. All foundation construction will be performed in strict accordance with the provisions of the 2012 NC State Residential Building Code, the General Scope of Elevation Work, and Engineering drawings included in the Bid Package.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside the name and address of the Bidder, the name of the project for which the bid is submitted, and the date and time of opening.

Beaufort County reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive any informality in any bid and to re-advertise for bids. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) calendar days after the date set for the bid opening.
