Crofton Construction Services, Inc. is seeking bids from SWAM and DBE certified contractors to bid on the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources USS North Carolina Battleship Cofferdam & Memorial Walkway, SCO# 13-10530-02. Crofton is seeking the following trades: erosion control, electrical, surveying, landscaping, and roofing.

Scope of Work:

Cofferdam: A 1,850 linear foot sheet-pile cofferdam will be constructed around the perimeter of the USS North Carolina Battleship. The cofferdam will be comprised of steel sheet pile supported laterally by structural steel walers that will be used as a wall cap on top of the sheet piles. All the steel shapes will be treated with a high performance epoxy coating. The ship is 730 feet long and 108 feet wide. Its hull is submerged 30 feet. The cofferdam will be constructed to facilitate the future repair of the ship's hull. The cofferdam will be dewatered and tested. The cofferdam will remain in place after the hull repair is complete. The hull repair is currently not in the scope of work but is planned as a future project.

Memorial Walkway: A 2,200 linear foot timber walkway structure that will also be constructed around the perimeter of the ship that will allow visitors to experience the ship at water level and its surrounding ecosystem. The walkway will have five wider areas for group gatherings. There will be two covered pavilions for use as an outdoor viewing area. It will be an open-air timber structure with a timber roof. There will be path lighting along portions of the walkway. The Memorial Walkway will be comprised of timber piles, split caps, stringers, decking, and guardrails, and will use timber x-bracing for lateral stability.
