ASBESTOS INSPECTION SERVICES

The Town of Plymouth has been awarded a Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the North Carolina Department of Commerce (DOC) in the amount of \$500,000 (100% of total program costs) to undertake a NC Catalyst Project. The grant includes acquisition, clearance, relocation and park development.

The Town of Plymouth is now accepting proposals for a certified contractor to provide asbestos inspections for approximately eight (8) dwelling units. These dwellings are single story residential and are approximately 700-1500 square feet in size.

All inspectors and project designers must have current certifications from institutions that are approved in accordance with current state and federal requirements for asbestos inspection activities. Attached are copies of the specifications necessary to complete this proposal. Please review these specifications carefully. The successful contractor will be required to provide proof of insurance (Attachment A).

Asbestos Inspection Request for Proposal

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to provide the Town of Plymouth information to help them manage and control asbestos hazards efficiently and effectively during demolition and clearance activities. This RFP is a request for an Asbestos Inspection prior to demolition activities. Enclosed is the following information on the properties to be evaluated:

- a. Proposal Sheet
- b. Location Map

All work must be performed by contractors certified to perform asbestos inspections and by individuals certified and licensed to perform such inspections by the State of North Carolina Health Hazards Control Unit (HHCU). The inspections will be conducted in general accordance with standards for conducting asbestos inspection activities. The inspections shall be conducted by a State of North Carolina accredited asbestos inspector.

The Town of Plymouth reserves the right to restrict the assignment of any individual, for any reasonable cause, under the contract or any subcontracts.

Scope of Work

The Asbestos Inspector shall provide all necessary facilities, materials, supplies, equipment, supervision, and personnel and other items and services to perform the asbestos inspection services as defined in this RFP. These services must be in accordance with applicable work practice standards of the HHCU. When more than one regulatory provision applies to a condition or activity, the most stringent shall be used.

Proposals are being requested to provide asbestos inspection services for approximately eight (8) dwellings scheduled for demolition. The units are scheduled to be cleared with funds received by the Town of Plymouth from the Division of Community Assistance. Contractors interested in bidding are requested to include the following information:

- Lump sum fee per unit for inspection.
- Price for analyzing additional samples.
- Any other charges which may be incurred to complete the inspection.
- All work shall be performed by a NC accredited Asbestos Inspector in accordance with state and federal regulations.
- Approximate response time between contract award and delivery of the completed Asbestos Report.

ATTACHMENT A

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Note to Bidders: The successful contractor shall be required to submit completed Attachment A before beginning work.

The service provider shall not commence any work in connection with this Request for Proposal until it has obtained all of the following types of insurance and such insurance has been approved by the Town of Plymouth. Nor shall the Service Provider allow any subcontractor to commence work on its subcontract until all similar insurance required on the subcontractor has been obtained and approved. All insurance policies shall be with insurers qualified and doing business in North Carolina recognized by the Secretary of State and the Insurance Commissioner's Office. The Town of Plymouth shall be furnished proof of coverage of insurance by certificates of insurance accompanying the contract documents and shall name the Town of Plymouth as an additional named insured.

The Town of Plymouth shall be exempt from, and in no way liable for any sum of money, which may represent deductible in any insurance policy. The payment of such deductible shall be the sole responsibility of the service Provider and/or subcontractor providing such service.

Indemnity and Insurance: To the extent permitted by law, the Service Provider shall indemnify and save harmless, the Town of Plymouth, its officers, agents, employees and assigns, from and against all loss, cost damages, expense and liability caused by an accident of other occurrence, resulting in bodily injury, including death, sickness and disease to any person(s), or damage or destruction to property, real or personal; arising directly or indirectly from operations, products of services rendered or purchased under this contract.

The Service Provider further agrees to purchase and maintain insurance with an insurance company rated not less than A by A. M. Best, authorized to do business in the State of North Carolina, acceptable to the Town of Plymouth.

1. Automobile Liability - Bodily injury and property damage liability covering all owned, non-owned, and hired automobiles for limits of not less than \$ 1,000,000 bodily injury each person, each accident and \$1,000,000 property damage, or \$ 1,000,000 single limit - bodily injury and property damage.
2. Comprehensive General Liability - Bodily injury and property damage liability as shall protect the Service Provider and any subcontractor performing work under this contract, from claims of bodily injury or property damage which arise from operation of this contract whether such operations are performed by the Service Provider, any subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by either. The amounts of such insurance shall be no less than \$ 1,000,000 bodily injury, each occurrence/aggregate and \$1,000,000 property damage combined limits each occurrence/aggregate. This insurance shall include coverage for products/completed operations, personal injury liability and contractual liability.
3. Workers' Compensation meeting the statutory requirements of the State of North Carolina and Employers Liability \$100,000 per accident limit, \$500,000 disease per policy limits, \$100,000 disease each employee limit providing coverage for all employees and owners.
