Executive Order 13

Support for Historically Underutilized Businesses

- **Signed by Governor Perdue May 7, 2009**
- **Expects all citizens to have equal opportunities to participate in State procurement and contracting**
- **Recognizes the definition of Historically Underutilized Businesses as defined in N.C.G.S. 143-128.4 and 143-48.4**
- **Includes 10% Aspirational Goal**
- **Encourages a coordinated effort to eliminate barriers for HUB firms seeking to do business with the State.**




Executive Order 13

(cont.)

- **HUB Office to provide technical assistance to agencies in development of outreach plan**
- **Office for Economic Recovery to encourage recipients of Recovery & Reinvestment funds to provide opportunities to HUB firms**
- **Directors of the State Purchasing Office, State Property Office, State Construction Office, all State Agencies and Secretary of N.C. DOT are to implement guidelines and procedures for HUB inclusion.**

- **N.C.G.S.143-48.4 and 143-128.4 (Formerly Senate Bill 320)**
- **Passed & Signed during the 2007 Legislative Session**

Application and Certification Process

Who Should Apply

- **Firms that are at least 51% owned, operated and controlled**
- **By a minority, woman, disabled (person with a disability), Disadvantaged (socially and economically individuals)**
- **HUB Eligibility Criteria (N.C.G.S. 143-128.4 and 143-48.4)**

Application and Certification Process

HUB Certification Categories

- **Minority:**
 - Black, Hispanic, Asian American, American Indian
- **Female**
- **Disabled - Person with a Disability**
- **Disadvantaged-Socially and Economically**

How to Initiate HUB Certification

- Go to HUB Office's Website:
www.doa.nc.gov/hub
- Register in Vendor Link as Vendor
- Apply for HUB Certification
 - Click "Request HUB Certification"
 - Click "Request HUB Certification" (*again*)
 - Click "Vendor Registration / HUB Certification"

Application and Certification Process (Cont.)

- **On the Electronic Registration page – read terms and if satisfied, Click “Accept”**
- **Complete all applicable information**
- **On the last page – Click “Registration Complete”**

Application and Certification Process

When to Submit Documents

- **Application and Required Documents must be submitted within 30 days from completion of request for Certification**
- **Electronic Reminder, if not received within 15 days**
- **Withdrawals**
 - **HUB Office may Withdraw, if documents not received**
 - **Vendors may also request withdrawal**

PLEASE NOTE: The State of North Carolina is implementing a new electronic procurement system. If you want to receive electronic purchase orders, your business must also be registered in this new E-Procurement Service. Registration in the E-Procurement Service will enable your business to participate in procurement opportunities from state agencies, universities, community colleges, public schools and local government entities. After you have made your commodity class selections and click on the **Next** button, you will be taken to the **Business Group Definition** screen. You are asked to complete questions pertaining to Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) status. If you are **not** a Historically Underutilized Business, your registration process is complete and you will receive e-mail notification from the Division of Purchase and Contract within two business days. If you are a Historically Underutilized Business, see the section pertaining to completing the information required for HUB certification. At this point you will be shown a summary or all the information that you have supplied. You can make changes to any of this information by clicking on the **Change Vendor Information** link. This will take you to the **Vendor Login** screen. After a successful login you will be presented with the **Vendor Change Menu**.


