**DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY**      **(Picture Attached)**

The NC State Surplus Property Agency on behalf of the N C State Port Authority is putting up for Sale and Removal a Gantry Crane, located at The Port Of Wilmington in Wilmington NC, which shall be referred to as Crane # 6. It is a rail mounted Gantry Crane, with a 32 foot rail gage, 40 foot portal clearance height, 273 feet overall trolley length, 138'-8" between bumpers and 87 feet clear under the spreader. The crane gantries have twelve (12) wheels per corner. The crane weighs approximately 986 metric tons.

**SCOPE AND NATURE OF WORK**

The successful Bidder and or the Contractor employed by the Bidder shall remove Crane No. 6 either by roll-off onto a vessel or barge, or by partial disassembly and removal by ground or water transportation, or by other methods approved by the NCSPA. The Contractor shall provide a description of the proposed method of removal with the bid. The Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary permits for disassembly, loading, and transportation of Crane No. 6.

**DESCRIPTION OF SITE**

The Contractor shall perform the removal/disassembly work in the area designated by the NCSPA at The Port of Wilmington. Adequate space will be provided for the work to be accomplished.

The Contractor shall have the responsibility to adequately secure Crane No. 6 and protect it from wind or other causes once the work has begun.

## DOCK LOADINGS

The Contractor must submit to the NCSPA for review, the type of equipment and description of the process which will be utilized to complete the removal/disassembly work to ensure that allowable yard and/or dock loadings are not exceeded.

The Contractor must submit to the NCSPA a Professional Engineer's certificate prepared by a Professional Engineer, legally authorized to practice engineering in the State of North Carolina, verifying that the removal/disassembly work will not exceed the allowable yard and/or dock loadings. The engineering calculations must be included with this certification.

## SECURITY AND C – TPAT COMPLIANCE

Upon award of the contract, the awarded contractor shall schedule a meeting with the Director of Safety and Security to meet compliance with NCSPA Security Initiatives and Compliance. The Contractor and Contractor employees will be subject to security background checks. The NCSPA reserves the right to require submission of employees of perspective contractor's criminal background checks during the evaluation of proposals.

## INSURANCE

It is required that the contractor provide and maintain in full effect at no additional cost to the State for the duration of this contract the following minimum amounts of insurance

Commercial General Liability insurance or Comprehensive General Liability insurance with a minimum limit of \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence.

Comprehensive Automobile Liability insurance with a minimum combined single limit of \$1,000,000.00 per accident

Worker's Compensation insurance as specified by State Law and employer's liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2,000,000.00 each accident and \$2,500,000.00 for bodily injury by disease.

Contractor's Pollution Liability Insurance with a minimum of \$2,000,000.00 per occurrence limit.

## REQUIRED PERFORMANCE BOND

The successful bidder will be required to post a **\$10,000.00 Performance Bond** in the form of a **Certified Check, or Money Order**, made payable to the State Surplus Property Agency. All or a portion of the Performance Bond may be withheld should the awarded contractor not perform the requirements as stated herein for the amount of loss to the agency requesting services and/or the State Surplus Property Agency.

## TIME OF COMPLETION

The Contractor shall commence work to be performed under this Contract on a date to be specified in written order from the NCSPA and shall fully complete all work hereunder within **45** consecutive calendar days from the Notice to Proceed. For each day in excess of the above number of days, the Contractor shall pay the Owner One Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$1000.00) per day as liquidated damages reasonably estimated in advance to cover the losses to be incurred by the NCSPA should the Contractor fail to complete the Work within the time specified.
