






The above map shows Court Districts with access to approved Domestic Violence Intervention Programs.


- Red counties have an approved program.

The above map uses combined numbers of intakes from criminal and civil court orders as well as probation/parole orders. This gives us an overall idea of which court districts are ordering offenders to attend a Domestic Violence Intervention Program.

Please note that due to a lack of accountability measures with civil court ordered offenders, this may not reflect the actual numbers of individuals ordered to attend and complete a Domestic Violence Intervention Program as a condition of a 50B Domestic Violence Protective Order
