

Domestic Violence in North Carolina



WHAT ARE THE SERVICES?

Services most provided include **information** (350,314) and **advocacy** (198,607 cases).



Shelter services can be dedicated facilities, local safe homes, or hotels. Space is limited, resulting in 4185 referrals made to other shelters.

Volunteers donated 186,180 hours.

Organizations also provided public-facing services, including 2,681 educational presentations and 2,068 professional trainings.

Sexual assault in North Carolina








WHAT ARE THE SERVICES?

Services most provided were **information** (72,000+ cases) and **advocacy** (almost 32,000 cases). Other services included **hotline calls** (27,183) and **chats** (3,621).



OFFENDER

Of the 11,797 reported offenders in cases of sexual assault, only 4% of assaults were perpetrated by strangers.



Volunteers donated **355,461** hours.

Organizations also provided public-facing services: **3,337** educational presentations and **1,543** professional trainings.
