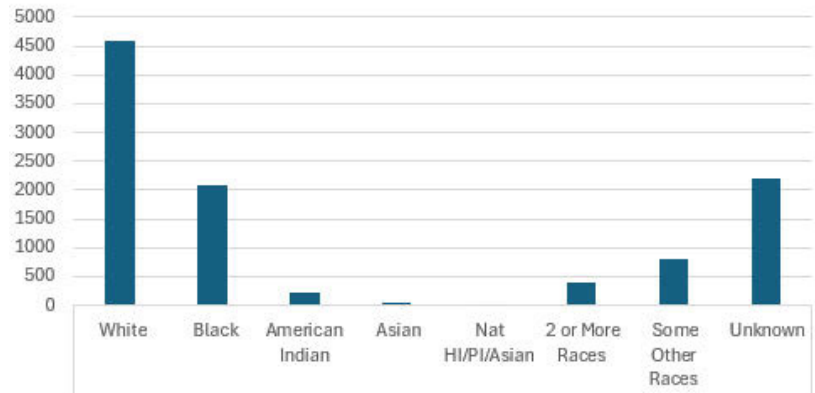

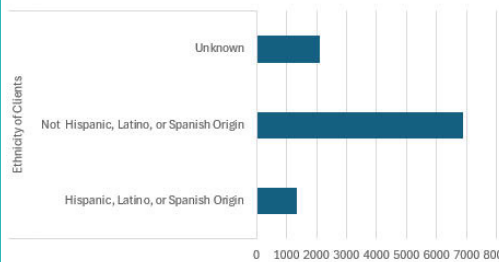

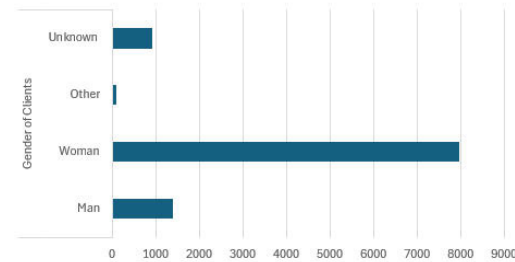
Race



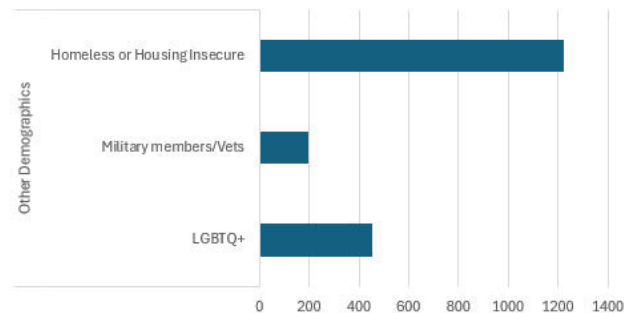
Ethnicity



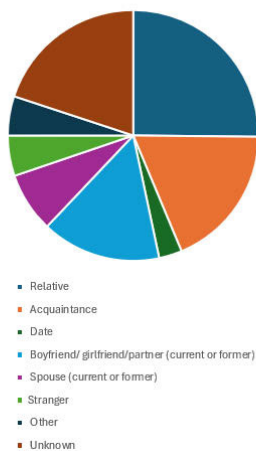

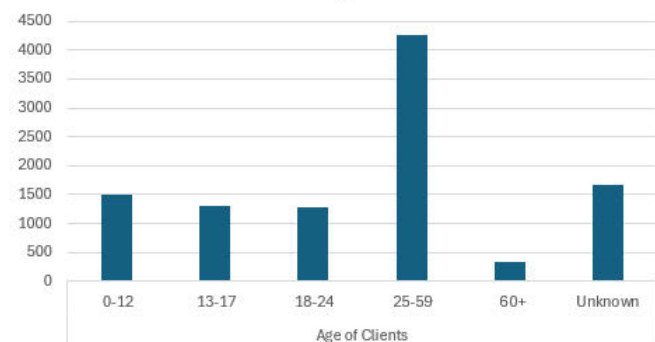
