




What do grantees provide to victims of domestic violence?

- ◇ 9,901 victims received shelter services, which refers to providing shelter in a facility or a local safe home or hotel
- ◇ 43% of clients that received shelter services were children
- ◇ Nearly 4,400 victims were referred to other shelters due to lack of space
- ◇ 11,414 support groups provided
- ◇ 27% of the support groups were for children
- ◇ Over 7,000 educational presentations & professional trainings conducted



Services Provided by Domestic Violence Agencies

Information (30%) and Advocacy (21%) make up over 50% of the total services provided. Other services provided include: job counseling, job training, financial, health education, education.



Domestic Violence Crisis Calls & Clients over 5 years

Between fiscal year 2016-2017 and 2017-2018, there was an increase in the number of crisis calls answered and clients served as reported by state-funded domestic violence agencies.








What do grantees provide to victims of sexual assault?

- ◇ Over **12,500** educational presentations & professional trainings conducted
- ◇ **3,807** support groups provided
- ◇ **16%** of the support groups were for children



Services Provided by Sexual Assault Agencies

Information (36%) and Advocacy (25%) make up over 60% of the total services provided by sexual assault agencies.



Sexual Assault Crisis Calls & Clients over 5 years

Between fiscal year 2016-2017 and 2017-2018, there was an increase in crisis calls answered and number of clients served as reported by state-funded agencies. Often, sexual assault is underreported.
