- Passed & Signed during the 2007 Legislative Session
- Collaborative Effort of the HUB Office, Statewide M/WBE Program Administrators, N M/WBE Coordinators' Network and Resource Organizations
- Gives Secretary of Administration the Authority to:
 - -Develop and Administer a Program for the Certification of a Historically Underutilized Business as defined in G.S. 143-128.4
 - -Create a Single Database of Certified HUB firms

Statewide Uniform Certification Program (SWUC)

- Developed criteria, which is the proposed SWUC Program Plan.

- Public Hearing for the proposed SWUC Rules was held January 14, 2009
- Another Public Hearing for the proposed SWUC Rules on April 8, 2009
- Program Implemented and Everyone uses by July 1, 2009
