






GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA SESSION 2013

SESSION LAW 2014-42 HOUSE BILL 1043

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE STATUTES RELATED TO THE USE OF PREQUALIFICATION IN PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTING, AS STUDIED BY THE JOINT PURCHASE AND CONTRACT STUDY COMMITTEE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-135.8 reads as rewritten:

"§ 143-135.8. Prequalification.

(a) Except as provided in this section, Bidders bidders may not be prequalified for any public construction or repair work project.

(b) A governmental entity may prequalify bidders for a particular construction or repair

work project when all of the following apply:

(1) The governmental entity is using one of the construction methods authorized in G.S. 143-128(a1)(1) through G.S. 143-128(a1)(3).

(2) The hoard or governing hody of the governmental entity adonts an objective

SECTION 8.(a) There is established a Blue Ribbon Commission to Study the Building and Infrastructure Needs of the State (Commission).

SECTION 8.(b) The Commission shall be composed of 20 members as follows:

 - Three members of the House of Representatives.
 - One person upon recommendation of the North Carolina League of Municipalities.
 - One member of the public, licensed as an architect in this State.
 - One member of the public, licensed as a professional engineer in this State.

 - The Secretary of Administration, or the Secretary's designee.
 - The President of The University of North Carolina, or the President's designee.
 - The President of the North Carolina System of Community Colleges, or the President's designee.
 - e. A member of the State Water Infrastructure Authority.
 - The Secretary of the Department of Commerce, or the Secretary's designee.
