# What is a HUB?



#### What is a HUB?



- Per NC General Statute <u>143-128.4</u>
- At least 51% of business is <u>owned</u> by one or more persons who are members of at least one of the groups in 143-128.4 (b).
- The <u>management</u> and daily business operations must be <u>controlled</u> by at least one owner in one of the groups in 143-128.4 (b).

#### **HUB Certification Categories**

- Black
- Hispanic
- Asian American
- American Indian
- Female
- Disabled
- Disadvantaged



# How do HUBs get Certified?



- Firms need to register for both IPS and HUB
- E-Procurement registration is optional <a href="https://vendor.ncgov.com/vendor/login">https://vendor.ncgov.com/vendor/login</a>

Certification lasts 4 Years, with 4-year recertification process.

It takes 45-90 days to determine if HUB once all documentation is received.

Reciprocity options if already certificated in a nearby state.

Vendors get a certification letter, there is no HUB certification number.



#### Why do HUBs need to be certified?

- According to NC General Statute <u>143-128.4 (e)</u>:
  - "Only businesses certified in accordance with this section shall be considered by State departments, agencies, and institutions, and political subdivisions of the State as historically underutilized businesses for minority business participation purposes under this Chapter."
- Some support programs are only available to certified HUBs.

# North Carolina Small Business Enterprise Certification Criteria

Governor Roy Cooper issued Executive <u>Order 143</u> to support and address the impacts of COVID-19 on Small Historically Underutilized businesses. The HUB Office was charged with creating a Small Business Enterprise (NCSBE) program. The NCSBE program is race, ethnicity and gender neutral.

#### Criteria

- For Profit business headquartered in North Carolina.
- The firm has an annual net income of not more than \$1,500,000, after cost of Goods Sold is deducted.
- The firm must have 100 or fewer employees.









#### **NCSBE Certification Process**

<u>HUB FIRM:</u> Actively HUB certified firms, **that meet NCSBE standards**, can be certified as a NCSBE vendor with the submission of an <u>affirmation letter:</u> <a href="https://files.nc.gov/ncdoa/documents/files/NCSBE-Affirmation-Letter-02.17.2021.pdf">https://files.nc.gov/ncdoa/documents/files/NCSBE-Affirmation-Letter-02.17.2021.pdf</a>.

**NON-HUB FIRM:** A firm that is **not** HUB certified can apply for NCSBE certification by submitting...








### Vendors in North Carolina


HUB Certifications in North Carolina (October, 2021)

North Carolina Department of Administration Historically Underutilized Businesse

- All firms in this search are HUB certified firms. You can opt to search for NCSBE certified firms.
  - Count changes frequently.
- You can search by company name, City, County, Commodities, Construction specialties.
- For company name search type in first 3-4 letters of company name (search is very literal).
- Use "%" in front of your search criteria if the name of the company does not start with your search criteria. Example: %plumb (to find plumbers).




# **HUB Vendor Search Example:**



- Minimum of 12 days before bids due (2 business days for posting, 10 calendar days before bids due).
